Why do we have a Dress Code?

- Limit classroom distractions
- Practice appropriate dress attire in the workplace
- Preserve safety within our school

FAILURE TO COMPLY

If You Arrive to School Wearing Inappropriate Dress, You Will:

- Be asked to cover up with clothing that you have in your locker or gym locker
- Remove articles such as: jewelry, bandanas or hats

OR

- Call a parent to bring appropriate clothing

Continuous Dress Code Violations

If there is a repetitive behavior in violating the Dress Code Policy, further action will be taken by Administration.

Dress Code Policy:

- No Undergarments showing
- No Midriff showing
- No Open Backs
- No Unnecessary Flesh or Cleavage exposed

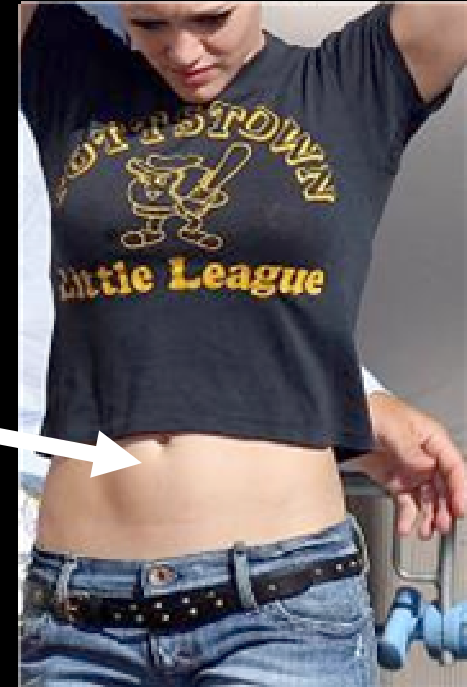

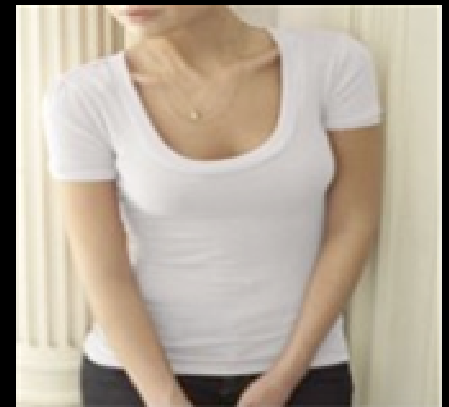
Examples of Attire: Open Backs



None of these shirts are acceptable to wear in school, UNLESS you wear a shirt under them!

Examples of Attire: Unnecessary Flesh or Cleavage

If you unable to bend over without exposing any unnecessary flesh or cleavage, you need to rethink your outfit!



Examples of Attire: Unnecessary Flesh

Warm weather may lead you to wear shorts or even skirts, but you must check for appropriate length!

*Outer layer of clothing-
Must be at arms length!*



Dress Code on Shirts

- Shirts must cover the shoulders
- Shirts must have fitted armholes

Dress Code Continued

- The wearing or display of confederate flag, swastika, or KKK signs/symbols is not permitted at school or school sponsored events
- Obscenities and gang graffiti are prohibited on clothing, books, agenda books, bags, and binders

Dress Code Continued

- Any clothing that displays tobacco, alcohol, drugs, drug paraphernalia, sexual innuendo, or offensive words, pictures or symbols is not allowed!

Dress Code Policy: Jackets

- Jackets are not to be worn in school UNLESS it is a Forest Lake Area sports jacket



Dress Code Policy: Pajamas or Slippers

- Wearing pajamas and/or slippers is not considered appropriate school attire
- Unless it is part of a school wide dress-up day!



Dress Code: Head/Hair Accessories

- Hats, bandanas, head coverings and sunglasses may not be worn in school
- When you arrive to school, immediately remove these items
- Head coverings are acceptable for religious purposes only

Dress Code: Head/Hair Accessories

- You are allowed to wear hair accessories if they are less than 1 inch thick
- If you fail to remove these items, they will be confiscated and returned to a parent or to the student at the end of the year!

Dress Code: Jewelry & Other Accessories

- Any article that may be used as a weapon will not be permitted
- These include chains, rings, bracelets, etc.
